SAMPLE SUBMISSION REQUIREMENT

SN	Dosage form	Minimum sample requirement*
1	Tablets/ capsules	200 tablets/capsules
2	Injections - Liquid	
	Ampoules/vials Less than or equal to 20 ml	50 units
	Others greater than 20 ml and less than 100ml	20 units
3	Injections – Powder for reconstitution (all sizes)	50 units
4	Suspension/Syrups - liquid	
	Less than or equal to 100mL	50 units
	Greater than 100 ml	20 units
5	Suspension/Syrups – powder for reconstitution	
	Less than or equal to 100mL	50 units
	Greater than 100 ml	20 units
6	Creams/Ointments	
	Less than or equal to 20g	30 units
	Greater than 20g	20 units
7	Infusions	
	Less than or equal to 500ml	20 units
	More than 500ml	20 units
8	Eye/Ear Drops – Less than or equal to 10mL	50 units
9	Raw materials	5g
10	Liquids[sterile] (solutions, eye/ear etc.) – Less than or equal to 20ml	50 units
11	Liquids [non sterile] (solutions) –greater than 20ml	20 units

*manufacturers unit packaging(s) is recommended

- Must be from the same batch
